Bats have good ears and a poor sight, That's why they hunt so late at night. What do you think? Aren't they nice? To me they look like flying mice.






CENTIPEDE

Chris the Crocodile Lives in the river Nile. Shiny little fish Are his favourite dish.






DONKEY

When eagles spread their mighty wings, They look like real avian kings. Please, do not come up to their nest, They've laid some eggs and need a rest.






ELEPHANT

Have you met Georgia, the giraffe? She's very cute and makes us laugh. She has the longest neck at the zoo. I think she's awesome? How about you?




HEN

Would iguanas make nice pets? Would they behave well at the vet's? Well, I think they would rather be free, Playing with friends and climbing a tree!






JAGUAR

Why are snails so slow? Hard to say, you know. I guess they must hate Always running late.


TIGER

Wolves are scary, wolves are fierce, Wolves have claws that tear and pierce. If you should meet, you'd better run. 'Cause such encounters are not much fun!


WOMBAT

But if you do, I am sure he will keep his cool.


ZEBRA
